

Barnes Elected to A.O. Smith Board of Directors

MILWAUKEE, July 12-- A.O. Smith Corporation (NYSE: AOS) today announced the election of W. Michael Barnes to its Board of Directors.

Barnes is senior vice president of finance and planning and chief financial officer of Rockwell International Corporation, a \$7 billion electronic controls and communications manufacturer headquartered in Milwaukee, Wis.

Barnes has held a number of engineering, finance, and executive positions during his 32-year career with Rockwell and its affiliated companies. He was elected a corporate vice president in 1989, responsible for business development and planning. He was appointed to his current position in 1991.
